## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Creation of the Children's Choir and Rhythmic Band with recycled material in Vietnam Los Mina, Santo Domingo Este.

# OBJECTIVES

- **General objectives**

Reduce and prevent the consumption of illicit substances, child prostitution, juvenile and child delinquency, as the consequences of leisure in the Vietnam community are undermined by Santo Domingo Este, Dominican Republic, creating the Level 1 Program for Eurythmic Choral Singing and Rhythmic Band with recycled material.

- **Specific objectives:**

- ✓ Creation Children's Choir (we have 100 children). Stimulation of the study of musical art.
- ✓ Creation of choral and rhythmic activities to strengthen artistic capacities.
- ✓ Meetings in artistic, educational and public places.
- ✓ Stimulate the Sensitivity of Choral Vocal Art, Promoting the choral musical culture.
- ✓ Calendar of Choral and Rhythmic activities.
- ✓ Promotion of folklore through Dominican peasant choral songs.

- ✓ Because the great benefits that music provides in the life of human beings at an early age must be accessible to everyone.
- ✓ Because we are certain that through music the quality of life of children and adolescents can be transformed. Therefore, we believe that we can reduce the figures of juvenile delinquency in our country by working from the communities of our Santo Domingo Este municipality.
- ✓ Because it is possible to live in harmony through the arts.
- ✓ Because it is necessary to decentralize the study of the art of music and take it to vulnerable communities.
- ✓ Because it is necessary to create an awareness of recycling and care for our planet in the children of the present.

# BACKGROUND

- The Vietnam community and surrounding neighborhoods, has long suffered the negative consequences generated by leisure, domestic violence and dysfunctional families. Among these multiple consequences, we have observed, child and juvenile delinquency, pregnancies in girls and adolescents, the consumption of illicit substances, prostitution and many more that derive from these already mentioned. Aware of the multiple needs of our vulnerable locality, we looked for alternatives within our reach that would reduce the impact of these consequences. In district number 2 of Santo Domingo Este, this program is the first one in this community.



## CONTEXT

The idea of creating a ductile children's choir program and making music with recycled material, stems from the need to "do with what we have" and at the same time contribute to the care of our environment, by recycling that broken bucket and turning it into a musical instrument, the leisure time that can lead infants to bad practices, is invested in favor of Education, our environment and our future.


